## TALLIE BRUNFELT, CONCERTMASTER

Violinist Tallie Brunfelt has been Concertmaster of the Akron Symphony Orchestra since 2017. Based in New York, she enjoys a busy freelance career, performing frequently on Broadway and in major concert venues including Carnegie Hall, Madison Square Garden, and Radio City Music Hall. She can be heard in many recent motion picture and television soundtracks, including *Joker*, *The Greatest Showman*, and *The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel*.



## ROBERT KISTLER, PRINCIPAL PERCUSSIONIST

Originally from New Jersey, Robert Kistler is the Principal Percussionist with the Akron Symphony and Section Percussionist with the Canton Symphony. As a freelance percussionist, he frequently plays with The Cleveland Orchestra, National Symphony, Detroit Symphony, and Cincinnati Symphony as well as various regional orchestras. He holds a master's degree from The Juilliard School, bachelor's degree from SUNY Purchase College Conservatory of Music, and a post-master's certificate from DePaul University.



## SARAH MILLER, CELLO

Originally from Long Island, N.Y., cellist Sarah Miller has been playing with the Akron Symphony since 2018. Sarah is a recent graduate from the Cleveland Institute of Music and is building her career as a performing cellist. Sarah especially enjoys recording and producing original arrangements of hymns with other musicians from her church, and is releasing an album of instrumental hymns in the coming months.



## BRIAN DEL BIANCO, BASS

Pittsburgh native Brian Del Bianco has been a member of the bass sections of the Akron and Canton Symphonies since 2001. He has performed regularly in Ohio, Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Michigan, as well as in Europe and the Cayman Islands in settings ranging from big band to rock to opera, with an emphasis on orchestral and musical theater ensembles. He also enjoys playing guitar and electric bass, and plays contrabass balalaika with the St. Nicholas Orthodox Church's balalaika orchestra.

# HOW TO REGISTER AND BID IN THE ONLINE AUCTION

---

**This bidding tips sheet describes everything you need to know about bidding in our auction, from registration through check-out:**

- Visit our event website at [rsabid.com](http://rsabid.com) and enter code 44308
- Sign in with your credentials for existing users, or click “Request an Account” to begin registration. You will be emailed a link to complete the registration process.
- From the event website, click “Check out the Catalog”
- You have the option to participate in standard bidding with manual entry, or using the automatic bidding robot that will continue to bid for you automatically up to the limit you specify
- When you’ve won or purchased an item, a **“\$” button** appears at the top of the eCatalog. Tap it to view your invoice and choose how you want to pay. You may pay as you win or purchase each item, or wait until the event’s end to pay for everything at once.
- Each time you pay an invoice, you’ll automatically receive an emailed receipt.
